 - A. First 5 Focus on DEI
 - a. Joelle reviewed the purpose of the document with the Commission. There was discussion about the DEI work and the Commission endorsed the work continuing.

 - a. Anti-Racist Parenting
 - i. Anne reported that the group is on their 2nd phase of the sprint. A book and materials for 1 activity were developed for parents to utilize with their children and there are plans to have parent discussion groups after.
